School Uniform expectations

At James Meehan High School we hold high expectations for all students. It is expected that all students will wear their school uniform with pride and in line with the following expectations.

- Uniforms must be suitable for the weather, winter coats/jumpers and track-pants should only be worn on cold days. Summer uniforms should only be worn during warm or hot weather. Students arriving in excessive clothing during summer or inappropriate length and or warmth for winter will be spoken to and parents/carers contacted.
- Substitutes for school purchased uniforms must be navy blue (shorts, jumpers, pants). Other colours are a breach of the policy and parents/ carers will be contacted regarding this.
- Sports uniforms may only be worn during sport time. Students are required to wear the day to day school shirt allocated to their year group.
- The wearing of any colour outside of the school colours is prohibited, brand symbols are also prohibited and under shirts must be navy blue.
- It is expected that if families are experiencing hardship a student assistance form should be filled out and returned to the school for assistance.
- Parents / carers are required to send a signed note outlining the reason for a student to be out of uniform if this is the case. Students that are consistently out of uniform may face consequences under the 'continued disobedience' rule.
- School shoes must be black, enclosed and leather. Sports shoes are only to be worn on sport day. Students are required to change into this uniform before the lesson begins.
