- if you become sick during an exam, let the supervisors know. A staff member from the school will come down and assess your health and decide what action to take next.

- if you are unable to attend your exam you must complete this process. You will need to speak with Mr Clements, Mrs Rogers and or Mr Khan straight away.

COVID TESTING:

- if you require a COVID test at any stage over the next four weeks, please inform the tester that you are a 2020 HSC student so they can fast track your results.
